



Lifeline Program

You may qualify for discounted telephone service

You may be eligible for a credit each month to lower the cost of your local phone service. The Lifeline program provides this benefit to eligible individuals and families.

What is Lifeline?

South Carolina offers a program to assist qualified low income individuals with charges for their telephone service called Lifeline. Lifeline provides a monthly credit of \$12.75 on a residential landline telephone bill.

Do I qualify?

If you receive Medicaid, Food Stamps or Family Independence, then you may qualify for Lifeline. To determine your eligibility for Lifeline and to enroll in this program, contact your local business office.
